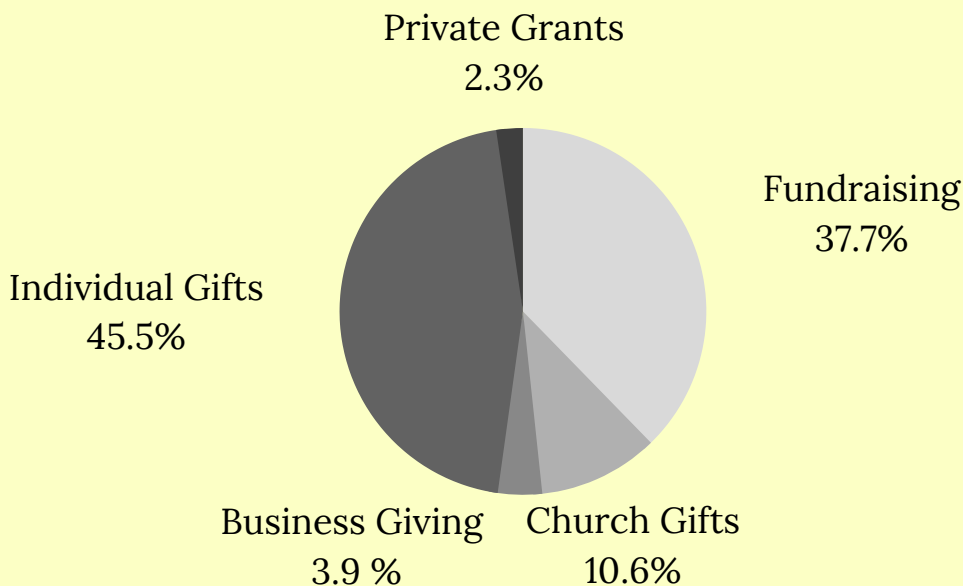

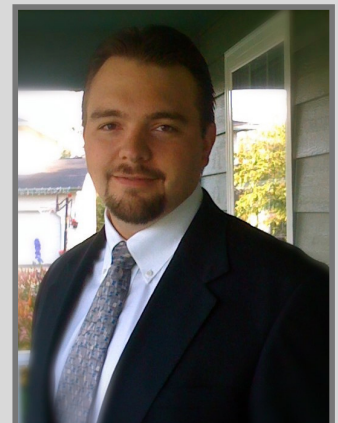

(Psalms 91:15) He continues to rescue us daily. Who could have predicted the national and global upheavals we have been and are still experiencing this year? Yet, amid all the heart-wrenching headlines and projected outcomes, we have witnessed some amazing accomplishments through HeartReach.

The confidence by which our staff/volunteers and Board of Directors have operated these past several months is a testimony to God's continued faithfulness. We have walked in trust and obedience to what the Lord has called us to accomplish, and we have seen His hand of mercy and grace. During the major shutdown of all business, HeartReach continued to provide essential services and continues to serve. Here are a few unique statistics that have not already been noted:

- 853 individuals were ministered to through the services of HRC.
- We prayed with 657 of those individuals.
- Amid state-wide shutdowns, we established on-line classes and personally mentored Embracing Parenthood Program clients over the phone.
- During this same time, we offered curb-side pick-up of emergency supplies such as diapers, wipes, formula, clothes, and food.
- We gave out approximately 13,960 diapers.
- Staff continued to meet daily for prayer, devotional time, and encouragement
- Together, we have developed new policies & procedures and have adjusted to new changes every day.

For those of you who have partnered with us in prayer, finances, and talents, we give you a hearty 'thank you' for your faithfulness. Your support allows us to equip individuals, families, babies, and children with vital services of care and compassion. Your generosity has allowed us to continue serving, engaging, and expanding. We are His hands and feet in ministering LIFE!

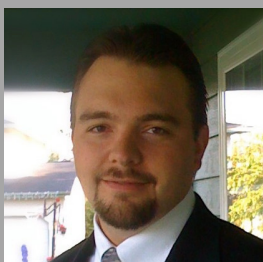

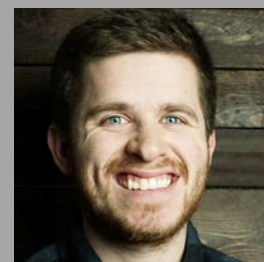
