Our mission will always be to intervene with abortion-minded/at risk individuals. An estimated 50% of all new STI cases each year occur in 15-24 year-olds, which also happens to be 50% of the demographic obtaining most abortions. Adding STI testing and treatment services demonstrates how seriously HRC takes its mission as well as a willingness to play on a larger field and adopt relevant strategies to engage today's culture.

# Why STI Testing & Treatment?

#### STI services will:

- Appeal to an abortion-minded/at-risk woman with a focus on her increased health-risks due to an active STI. The services of STI screening are not typically provided at an abortion clinic. This added resource sets HRC apart and demonstrates a "whole person" care approach.
- Better serve existing and future pregnant clients. The CDC estimates that 50% of all new STI cases each year occur in 15-24 year-olds, which also happens to be 50% of the demographic obtaining abortions each year. It is estimated that undiagnosed STIs cause 24,000 women to become infertile each year.

These are significant advantages, which no amount of marketing can replace!

- Enhance sexual risk avoidance discussions.
- Offer Physicians, PAs, NPs and RNs a place to volunteer in their areas of expertise and enrich medical credibility within the community.
- Provide the answer for bridge-building with the negative pregnancy test client while allowing HRC to become the face of POSITIVE reproductive health services to our community.

## 4tho are our clients?

HeartReach has been busier than ever! We are seeing more clients in each area of service we provide. Pulling out one client story to paint a picture of how HRC serves is difficult because such variety exists in whom we are seeing, why we are seeing them, and how we are helping.

A young lady came to us recently for a pregnancy test. She was very sure she wanted an abortion because of her "unique and difficult circumstances" but when she and her boyfriend saw their baby on screen, they decided to choose life for their unborn child and will continue to work with HeartReach as they now decide whether to parent or make an adoption plan.

Another client had fled her country to escape a controlling, abusive, and dangerous relationship. Her first appointment took three hours just to understand the major details of her story, determine what was needed, and to find additional resources to successfully get on her feet and avoid the abusive man who had threatened to kill her and her child.

A former male client recently stopped in to see his mentor and to share how God had been restoring him. He had received Christ as his Savior six months into attending the Fatherhood program in 2016.

Several clients have been referred to us from OCS (Office of Children Services) because they have lost their children due to addiction, violence, or inadequate care. These clients come in for parenting classes.

One couple has been working with us weekly for five months and is faithful to come and do all they can to regain their child. God is at work in their story, and we look forward to the day this family is reunited.

Earlier in the year, we had another father walk in with his little girl to show us he had her back after working consistently with a mentor to regain her custody. He was overjoyed.

A single mom came in for emergency needs assistance and was told about our parenting classes. A staff member overheard her talking about post-partum depression and decided to invite her into a mentor room to talk privately. With encouragement, that mom was steered back to her obstetrician for medical care and has been meeting with a mentor ever since.

Through these snapshots of client stories, we hope you see that HRC is not just about "saving a baby from abortion." Being able to come alongside a mother and father to sustain a dependent life is also vital to the long-term health and wellbeing of a child and the generational health of a family.

Please keep us in your prayers whenever you drive by HeartReach or think of us. **Battles are being fought for lives within our walls, and we never want to tire of doing the work God has called us to do.**
